Topic: Subject and predicate

Synopsis:

- A sentence has two parts Subject and Predicate.
- Subject is the naming part. It tells who or what the sentence is about.
- Predicate is the telling part, it tells what someone or something is or does.
- For eg: The gardener watered her flowers. So the gardener is the subject, watered her flowers is the predicate.
