Chapter 1- Our Country- India

Synopsis:

- . India is the seventh largest country in the world.
- . Afghanistan, Pakistan, China, Nepal, Bhutan, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Maldives are our neighbours.
- . India is divided into five physical divisions.
- . The physical divisions of our country are as follows:
 - a. The Northern Mountains or the Himalayan Region
 - b. The Northern Plains
 - c. The Great Indian Desert or the Thar Desert
 - d. The Southern Plateau
 - e. The Coastal Plains
 - f. The Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep Island

India's length from Jammu and Kashmir in the north to Kanyakumari or Kanniyakumari in the south is about 3,200 km.

- . It's breadth from Gujrat in the west to Arunachal Pradesh in the east is around 2,900 km.
- . An area of land surrounded by water on three sides is called a peninsula.
- . A plateau is a relatively flat land that is higher than the land around it.
- . The southern part of India is a peninsula and is shaped like a cone. It is surrounded by the Bay of Bengal along the east coast, the Arabian Sea along the west coast and the Indian Ocean in the south. The southern most tip of the main land is Kanyakumari.
- . India is the second most populated country in the world.
