Adding 'ing' to a word tells us that the action is on going or what he/she is doing now.

When a word ends with one or more consonant we can just add 'ing' to the word.

Eg: draw +ing' = drawing

Eat + ing' = Eating

How ever when a word ends with a vowel eg: 'e' we should remove the 'e'

Before adding 'ing'

Eg : hide = hiding

Dance = dancing

And when a word ends with one short vowel and one consonant

We double the consonant before adding ing'.

Eg : cut cutting

Run running.
