### **SYNOPSIS**:

There are 26 letters in the English alphabet. The letters a, e, i, o and u are called **vowels.** All the other letters such as b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, y and z are called **consonants.** 

An **article** is a word used to modify a noun, which is a person, place, animal or thing. An article is a word that comes before a noun. There are three articles – **a**, **an**, **the**.

### Rules of using these articles :

### Use of a and an :

- 'A' comes before singular nouns that begin with a consonant sound.
   For example : <u>a</u> rat, <u>a</u> ball.
- 'An' comes before singular nouns that begins with a vowel sound.
   For example : <u>an</u> apple, <u>an</u> egg.
- We use 'a' or 'an' to speak of someone or something for the first time. They are used with a noun in general.

For example : Roshan bought <u>a</u> bat yesterday.

Rahul wants to eat <u>an</u>ice – cream.

## Use of the :

• **'The'** is used when we talk about a particular person, place, animal or thing.

For example : <u>The</u> dress is pink in colour.

<u>**The**</u> children are playing outside.

• We use ' **the**' when the same noun is used for the second time. For example : We have <u>a</u> test tomorrow.

We want to do well in <u>the</u> test.

In the above sentence, **a** is mentioned for the first time but **the** is mentioned for the second time.

• **'The'** is used with plural nouns. It is used when naming a noun that refers to an entire group of its kind.

For example : the earth, the sky, the moon, the sun.

- We use ' **the'** with the following :
  - The names of rivers, seas, oceans, mountain ranges.
    For example : <u>the</u> Kaveri, <u>the</u> Indian Ocean, <u>the</u> Himalayas.
  - The names of famous buildings.
    For example : <u>the</u> Gateway of India, <u>the</u> Red Fort, <u>the</u> Victoria Memorial.
  - The names of holy books, newspapers, magazines.
    For example : <u>the</u> Gita, <u>the</u> Bible, <u>the</u> Statesman.
  - The names of trains, ships, aeroplanes, etc.
    For example : <u>the</u> Rajdhani Express, <u>the</u> Akbar (name of a ship), <u>the</u> Air India.
  - The names of some countries ( the name contains a common noun ).
    For example : <u>the</u> U.S.A., <u>the</u> U.K.

In the above example, U.S.A. stands for United States of America in which the word **states** is a common noun.

In the same manner, U.K. stand for United Kingdom in which the word **kingdom** is a common noun.

• We do not use ' **the**' before names of people and countries(only when it contains no common noun in the name).
